HOW AN ENDORSEMENT IS MADE

It starts with you, and ends on your ballot.

- 1 ELECT YOUR DELEGATES**
Union members elect delegates to their area's Central Labor Council.
 - 2 VET THE CANDIDATES**
Delegates dig through voting records and public statements, then interview candidates face to face.
 - 3 VOTE TO RECOMMEND**
The council votes on which candidates to carry to the statewide convention.
 - 4 THE FINAL VOTE**
Delegates from unions across Kansas make the call at the KS AFL-CIO COPE Convention.

A democratic majority of Kansas union members stands behind every name on this flyer.

WICHITA PUBLIC SCHOOLS BOND

There are two bond questions on your ballot, and labor is asking for a yes vote on both. Together they rebuild and repair schools across Wichita, picking up where the 2008 bond leaves off.

QUESTION 1

Rebuilds Truesdell, Black, McLean, and Chisholm Trail, renovates Cessna with a K-8 addition, preserves East and North High, builds a new Future Ready Center at East, puts HVAC in gyms and other learning spaces, and fixes traffic flow at select schools. It picks up where the 2008 bond leaves off, so **your tax rate does not go up**.

QUESTION 2

Rebuilds Coleman and Adams, moves Irving into Horace Mann, and upgrades South, Northwest, West, and Heights. About \$4 a month on a \$200,000 home. Question 2 only counts if Question 1 passes, so **vote yes on both**.
